2. Willington must assess and reduce energy use in all public facilities by at least 10%.
3. For every 100 households that sign up for Clean Energy Options, a free renewable energy system will be installed on a public building.

Sample additional costs per 100 kilowatt hours if you choose 100% (1/2 for 50%)

- 150 kwh = \$1.70
- 300 kwh = \$ 3.40
- 450 kwh = \$ 5.09
- 600 kwh = \$ 6.80
- 900 kwh = \$10.56
- 1000 kwh = \$11.52

Chances are good that your household will be motivated to reduce its electric use and cancel out the additional cost.
