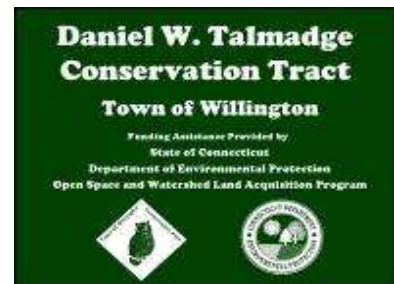


The Willington Conservation Commission presents:

CT Trails Day – Talmadge Spur Hike

June 7th (Sat.) 9:30–11:00 am Talmadge Trail Spur

The Willington Conservation Commission and the Connecticut Forest & Park Association invite you to join us for a light morning hike on the Talmadge Trail Spur to the Blue-Blazed Nipmuck Trail, right here in Willington.



This is a new 1.5 mile loop trail over rolling wooded terrain that starts and ends on Mason Road. Along the way we will look and listen for many resident and migratory birds that use the mature forested area and lower wetland for nesting. Bring beverage, camera and binoculars.

The hike takes place on Saturday, June 7. We will meet up at the Talmadge Spur Trailhead off of the south end of Mason Road in Willington, approximately ¼ mile north of the intersection with CT Route 44.
