Here is a Connecticut wildlife video presentation that has to be seen to be believed!



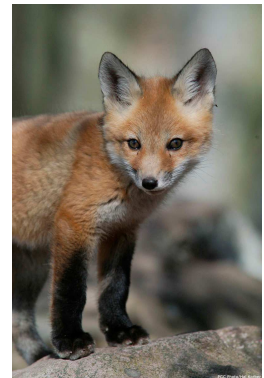

Andy Rzeznikiewicz has spent years capturing a large variety of our native mammals on high quality remote video cameras on and around the Pomfret woodlands, and is coming to Willington to share them with us.

Come see bobcats, coyotes, fishers, weasels, owls, and all manner of creatures in their natural environment, observing their behavior during both the day and in the middle of the night.



Adults and children are welcome to this free event. The presentation will be in the Community Room, located on the lower floor of the Willington Public Library. The Library is located on the corner of Ruby Road (Rt 320 North) and Rt 74, just west of the Willington Town Green.
