## COVID-19 Update

Willington was elevated to a Red Alert Level. Our 2 week rate stands at 17 per 100,000.

We have been in communication with our local health district to monitor our case counts and will continue to work to assess our community's needs.

While we remain in the Red Alert level the Town is cancelling or postponing public events indoors and outdoor events where social distancing and mask wearing is a problem. We recommend the following for all Community organizations and residents:

- Cancel all public events
- Postpone all indoor organized group gatherings
- Postpone outdoor organized activities where people wear social distancing and mask wearing is a problem.
- Recommend everyone in the community get tested for COVID
- High risk individuals stay home

We need to be aware that cases are on the rise and each do our part to help stop the spread. Please wear a mask, maintain physical separation, and wash your hands!
