### IV. Director's Report

- Facilities:
  - Stavens came out to RRAC last week and fixed the drainage issue. The irrigation is ready for winterization.
  - o Pickleball Court have to submit CIP budget by end of December
    - Decided to stick to the quote from Hinding
  - O Porta potty picked up for season, the company suggested a trash can be put inside the unit next year. Discussed a new location for the unit. The public is also disposing of their own garbage in the trashcans at River Road Athletic Complex, Public Works has had to clean up various items including mattresses. Porta Potty will need to be brought back in the spring time.
  - o River Road Athletic Complex lighting project is on hold, all the light bases are there at the park. Public Works is unable to dig while the ground is frozen, can't trench it, but planning to get them installed before the snow storms.

## Programs:

- Turkey Scavenger Hunt at Fenton Ruby and at River Road Athletic Complex had over 50 people registered. Good event over Thanksgiving break, found turkeys within the park, included riddles, trivia, create a song, and fun activities. Made the trip interactive for families.
- o Holiday Wreath Giveaway.
- Virtual Gingerbread House Competition had 20 people registered. Voting poll will go up soon. Three categories: Adult, Youth, and Family.
- A Tour of Holiday Lights is planned with Ashford, Coventry, Mansfield, and Tolland. Families in these towns decorated their homes and added them to a map, shared the map with the public for people to drive around and see holiday light displays. Safe activity while other events were cancelled around the holidays. There are prizes for: Best Traditional House, Best Animated and Best Overall. Winners will be posted on Monday.
