Weekly monitoring of bathing water quality has been resumed for Summer 2018. Enclosed please find the results from water samples taken at *Halls Pond*. The results indicate that the E.coli levels in the water were:

Date	E. Coli Level	Geometric Mean
07/09/18	10	19.90517971

We will keep you updated by mailing results on a weekly basis. If a situation arises that requires immediate attention we will notify you by telephone.

The Commissioner of Health Services has established that concentrations of the E. coli indicator organism less than or equal to 235 per 100 ml is generally considered satisfactory. A single sample with a concentration of the indicator organism greater than 235 per 100 ml is in excess of that which is normally considered acceptable for bathing and a resample is required. Factors that may influence the growth of this organism include large populations of waterfowl, the number of bathers, and the amount of rainfall received at the time of testing.
