Public Works: will remain closed to the public but can be contacted at 860-684-9313 with any questions and/or emergencies. The staff will continue to work their normal hours but will be maintaining a safe distance from all residents for everyone's health and safety.

<u>Transfer Station</u>: will maintain normal business hours on Wednesdays, Saturdays and Sundays from 8:15-3:45 p.m. The Swap Shed will remain closed until further notice. For the safety of our staff and residents, please practice social distancing at all times. *Staff will not be able to assist residents with their trash removal.* For the time being, all bottles and cans should be placed in the recycling bin. <u>Willington Food Pantry</u>: will operate on a "by appointment" basis and change to providing prepackaged bags.
